



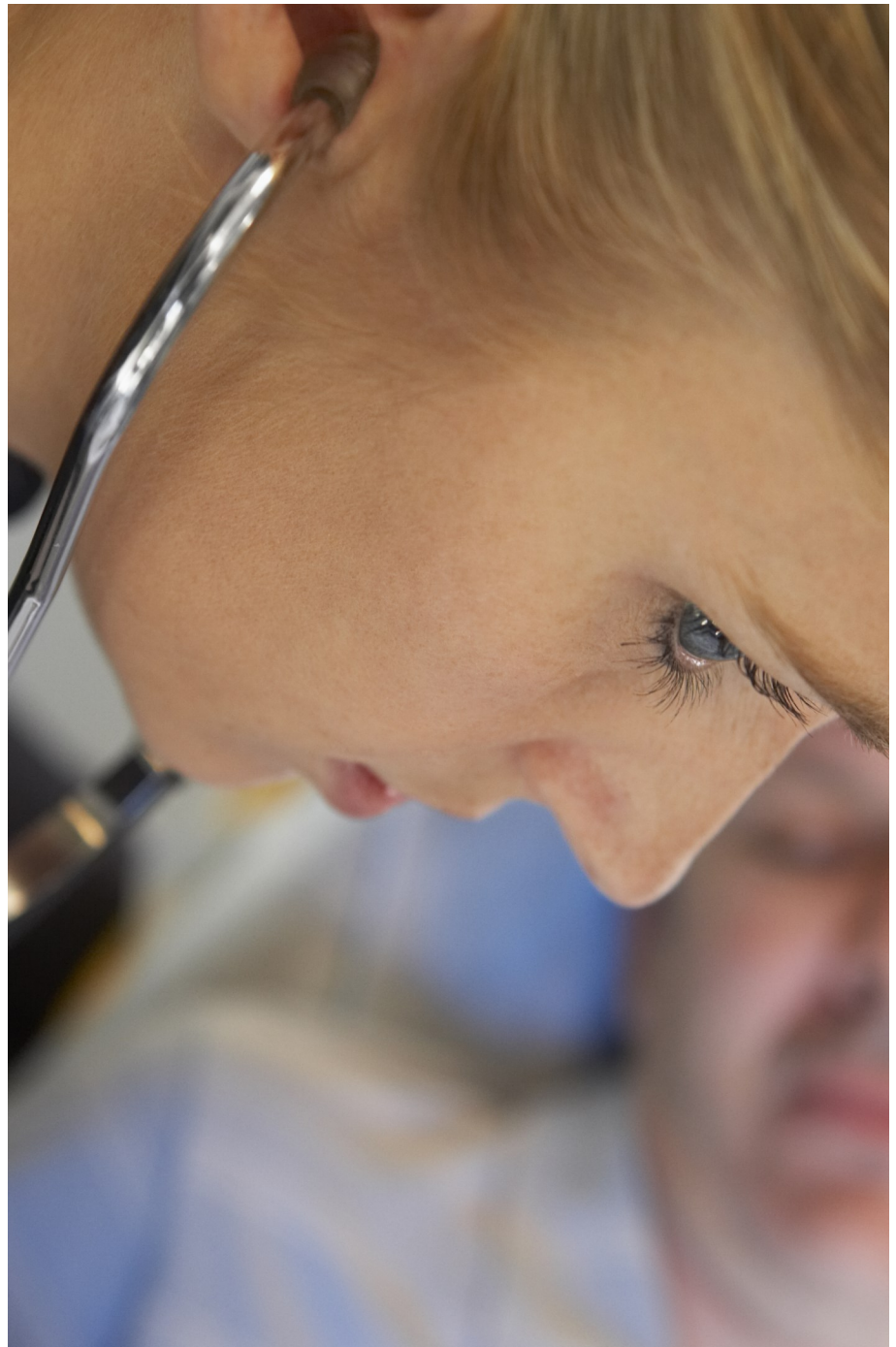
Bachelor of Science in Healthcare Administration
